Gianluca Neglia is a Full Professor of Animal Science at the Department of Veterinary Medicine and Animal Production of the University of Naples "Federico II". He obtained his Degree in Veterinary Medicine and his PhD in Animal Breeding Science at the same university.

His research focuses on Precision Livestock Farming, productive and reproductive management of livestock species (particularly buffaloes), biotechnologies applied to animal reproduction, animal welfare, nutrition, and the quality of animal products. He was Coordinator of the Master Degree in Precision Livestock Farming and is a member of the Teaching Board for the PhD program in Veterinary Sciences. His scientific activity is summarized in more than 300 publications, presented at national and international conferences and published in international scientific journals
